- Annual blood pressure screen
- Annual dental cleaning: includes dental assessment, anesthesia, monitoring, scale and polish and 6 dental survey radiographs (does not include any oral surgery or medications)
- Vaccinations, which may include: Distemper, Adenovirus, Parainfluenza, Parvovirus (DAPP), Leptospirosis, Bordetella and Rabies. Vaccinations and frequency of administration are based on AAHA guidelines
- Nail trim included with each visit
